WEIGHT CLASSES: 100, 105, 110, 115, 120, 125, 130, 135, 140, 145, 155, 170, 190, 235
Scratch +2 (as long as wrestler has made scratch prior to this event)

TIMELINE FOR DISTRICT REGISTRATION (Trackwrestling.com):

Host teams window opens:	Wednesday January 26
Assigned teams window opens (starters):	Sunday, January 30 (Noon)
Starters Window Closes	Wednesday, February 2 (Noon)
Teams can register backups:	Wednesday, February 2 (6 pm)
Window closes:	Friday, February 4 (10 pm)
Districts:	Sunday, February 13

Note - Extras will be capped at 16. (Ex. If there are 15 starters in a bracket, we will only accept 1 extra. First to sign up gets the spot.)

WEIGHT: Wrestlers will get 2 pounds (ex. 100 = 102). Every wrestler **MUST** have made scratch weight prior to the event if she will utilize the 2 pound allowance. **HOME WEIGH-INS DO NOT COUNT TOWARD INITIAL CERTIFICATION.** If she has **NOT** made scratch weight prior to the meet, she must do so on the first weigh in.

- a. Coaches must bring their team alpha and proof of your wrestler(s) weighing in at scratch weight (weigh in sheet signed by opposing coach and official)
- b. If an opposing coach wants to challenge a wrestler who they think may not have made scratch weight prior to the event, a formal request in writing (email) must be submitted to Dominic DiSabato (dominic_disabato@hboe.org) by Wednesday, Feb 9. Any challenges after this date will NOT be accepted.

QUALIFYING: *At least one coach per participating school must be a current member of the OHSWCA for their athlete to compete.*

Each competitor must be on the team's Alpha Roster and have completed the weight assessment. This State Meet follows all rules set by the OHSAA. Competing in this tournament DOES NOT count against tournament points for the wrestler/team (same as state duals).

REGISTRATION:

1. Register on Track Wrestling.

 - b. Your school COUNTY dictates what District you are assigned to. Please be sure to register at the correct site or your athlete will go to the bottom of the list in your correct location

PAIRINGS:

Pairings will be posted by TBD on Track Wrestling. Seeding criteria will be used at each site. Any challenges will need to be made a host school after weigh-ins

Girls District Seeding (based on girls matches only)

1. 2021 State Champ
2. 2021 State Placer

3. 2021 State Qualifier (1-4 District)
4. 2020 State Champ/Placer
5. 2021 District Placer (5th/6th)
6. Won/Loss record (by percentage) from current season (minimum of 12 matches). Must have a .500 or above record.

**If there is a "tie" with criteria, we will follow the following criteria:

1. Current best record %
2. Highest number of wins
3. Coin flip

Seeding Meeting

A coach may challenge a seed based only on the criteria listed below and the coaches will then vote on the challenge in this listed order: **Challenges submitted by 6 pm Saturday evening to the tournament director.**

- Head-to-head competition
- Each challenge to a seed nomination will be addressed separately.
- Disposition of each challenge will be made by a vote of all coaches or concession by the coach of the nominated seed under challenge

Sunday, February 13, 2022

- 7:00am building and scales open
- 8:00am – Weigh-ins and skin checks begin, by weight class, until complete. Please have all OHSAA skin forms in the girls hands
- 8:45 – Seed meeting to challenge seeding criteria based on Head to Head matchups. Very brief description then a coaches vote (if there is need). We are NOT going back to 1997 and having a 3 hour debate.
- 10am – Wrestling begins on three mats

All 14 weights competing at same time.

Host schools have freedom to adjust times according to their school district guidelines

Team personnel pass is needed for admittance, bullpen entrance and to sit matside.

We will follow the OHSAA procedures for skin check and weigh-ins for female wrestlers.

Please have qualifier passes for wrestlers at weigh-ins. Your wrestler will be stamped at the scale.

All wrestlers will be present and remain in the designated area (Main Gym) by weight classes. Each weight will be escorted up to the scales in the wrestling room, located behind the bleachers in the main gym.

1. All OHSAA Skin Authorizations appropriately signed and dated must be present at weigh-ins
2. Weigh-ins will begin at 100 pounds and conclude at the end of the 235 pound weight class. Wrestlers can step on and off the first scale 2 times, then if she still does not make weight, she can check the other scales one time

TEAM MEALS, LOCKER ROOMS, HOSPITALITY ROOM: Host school policy

COACHES MEETING: To be determined by the host school

ALL WRESTLING TIMES ARE APPROXIMATE:

Sunday Feb 13, 2022:

Championship Round 1: 10 am

Wrestle until finals with breaks determined by host tourney director

Finals - 1st, 3rd place, 5th place (5th place will be the state alternate)

Awards: The Championship team and Runner-up team will be awarded a team trophy. Each weight class winner will receive a bracket poster. No other individual awards will be given.

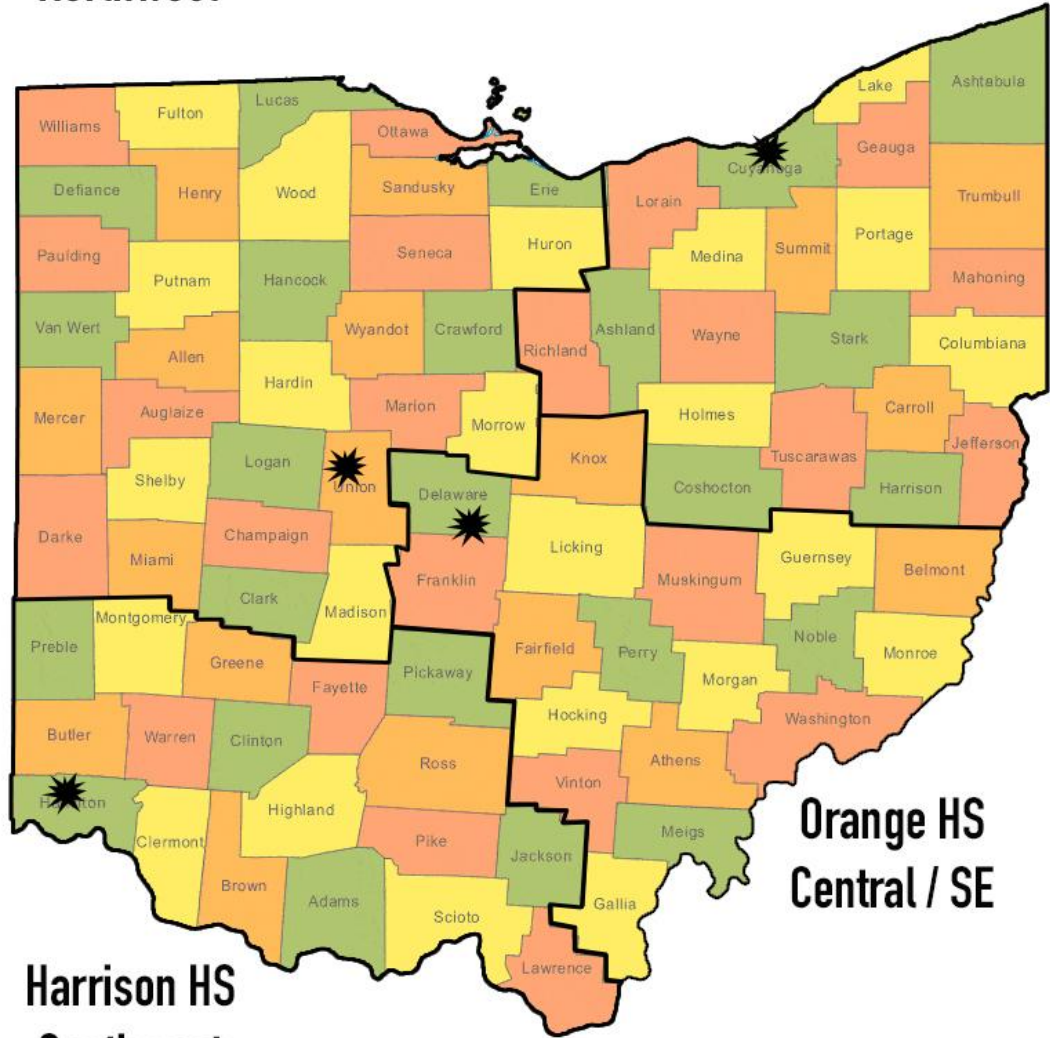
Entry Fee

1. \$30 per wrestler (fee enters athlete in district, no additional fee for state).
2. Team cap at \$300. (If you have 11 wrestlers or more, please make arrangements with Dominic DiSabato for your school to pay by check. DO NOT PAY ONLINE)
3. Admission - \$10 for entire day
 - a. Streaming will be determined by each site.
